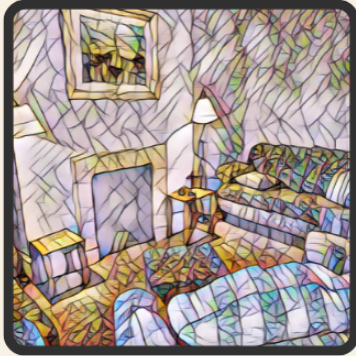


A lasting gift

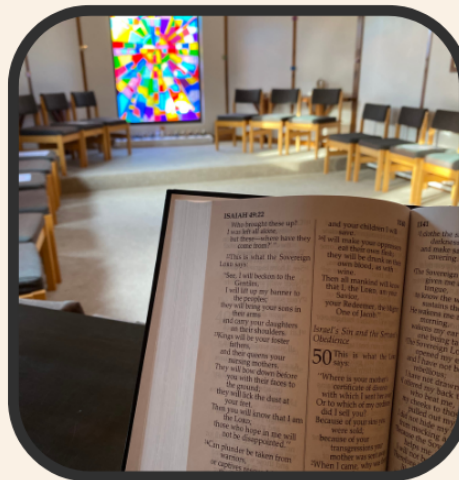
Leaving a legacy

We often hear that their gift is a testimony to the faithfulness, goodness and generosity of God and their thankfulness for CCHC.

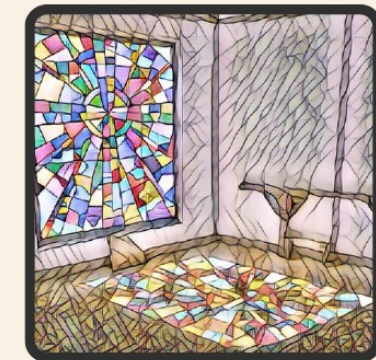
I want to encourage everyone old and young to make a will, review it regularly, and consider the difference a gift in your will could make.
